



## Thai AirAsia student pilot recruitment program 2012

### Qualifications

- Thai national, age not over 28 years (date of birth from 1 October, 1984 onwards)
- Exempt from military service
- University graduated with a bachelor's degree
- Good command of spoken and written English
- TOEIC 550 or Equivalent.(Validity must be within 31 August 2012)
- Excellent health and good eyesight (Lasik or PRK is accepted only more than 1 year)
- Minimum height 163 cms
- Free of criminal record and never been arrested for drunk-driving.

### Applicants are to follow the below instructions :

#### Step 1 E-Application

1. Application is to be made via website [www.airasia.com](http://www.airasia.com) only.
2. Each Applicant must upload the required document upon applying. The following documents are;
  - Identity card
  - Transcript or copy of bachelor's degree certificate or equivalent

After completed, applicant will receive the Application's ID. This application's ID can be printed out only when finished sumitting the application fee.

3. The non - refundable application fee is THB **700-**. After transferring, the applicant should upload the transaction via internet again so the application's ID can be printed out.
4. Each applicant should carry the application's ID and Two colored one-inch photos throughout the recruitment process.

#### Step 2 Basic Knowledge Test

1. The following document required to check before the test.
  - Application's ID.
  - Identity card.
2. Applicants will be given three sets of tests:
  - Tests of subject areas essential in pilot work namely Mathematics and Physics (Logics, Natural Science, Technical, Perceptual and Spatial). (100questions)
  - English Knowledge Test that involves testing applicants' ability to listening and reading comprehension. (100 questions)
  - Basic Aptitude Test such as Speed of Perception, Spatial Orientation, Memory, Logical Thinking Test. (100 questions)
3. Applicants must be at the test room on time. They must be properly attired, carry their applicant's ID, identity card. Writing instruments will be provided. Computers, calculators, mobile phones and other personal belongings are not allowed in the test room.
4. Results of the Basic Knowledge Test will be announced via [www.airasia.com](http://www.airasia.com)
5. Applicants must pass the Basic Knowledge Test in order to qualify for Step 3, Interview.

### Step 3 Interview

1. The following documents are to be submitted with **original** and **one copy**:
  - Two colored one-inch photos (taken within three months prior to the application date)
  - Identity Card or Government Employee Card
  - House Registration Certificate
  - Document of exemption from military service
  - Transcript and Degree
  - TOEIC 550 or Equivalent.(Validity must be within 31 August 2012)
2. Applicants will be interviewed by the Thai AirAsia Pilot Selection Committee.
3. Applicants must be at the meeting room on time. They must be properly attired.
4. Results of the interview will be announced via [www.airasia.com](http://www.airasia.com)

### Step 4 Medical Examination

1. Applicants will be required to undergo a medical examination at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor room 1, Institute of Aviation Medicine, Royal Thai Air Force (a four-storey building on the left of Bhumiphol Hospital), 171 Phaholyotin Road, Bangkok 10220
2. A non-refundable test fee of THB 2,800.- per person will be paid by each pilot candidate on the day of the test. (Prices can be changed without notice prior to Institute of Aviation Medicine)
3. Preparation guideline for the medical examination is to abstain from food 12 hours (after 2400 hrs) prior to the medical examination. A small amount of water may be consumed, if absolutely necessary.
4. Applicants who ever have lasik or PRK surgery, should bring your doctor certificate to show before medical examination.
5. Applicants must be in proper attire, bring along their applicant's ID, identity card, one colored one inch of photo and writing instruments.

### Step 5 Aviation Psychological Tests

The Physical and Mental Check comprises the following :

#### 1. Aviation Psychological Group Test

- The test will be held at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor room 1 the Institute of Aviation Medicine , , Royal Thai Air Force during 08.00-12.00 a.m. The candidates are recommended to have their breakfast and be at the test room not later than 07.30 a.m.
- Applicants must bring along their applicant's ID, identity cards, one colored one inch of photo and writing instruments.
- The receipt will be shown before the test.

#### 2. Aviation Psychological Individual Test.

- The Interview will be arranged by Medical Psychologists. One day consists of 6 applicants.
- The test will be held at room 223, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Institute of Aviation Medicine, RTAF.
